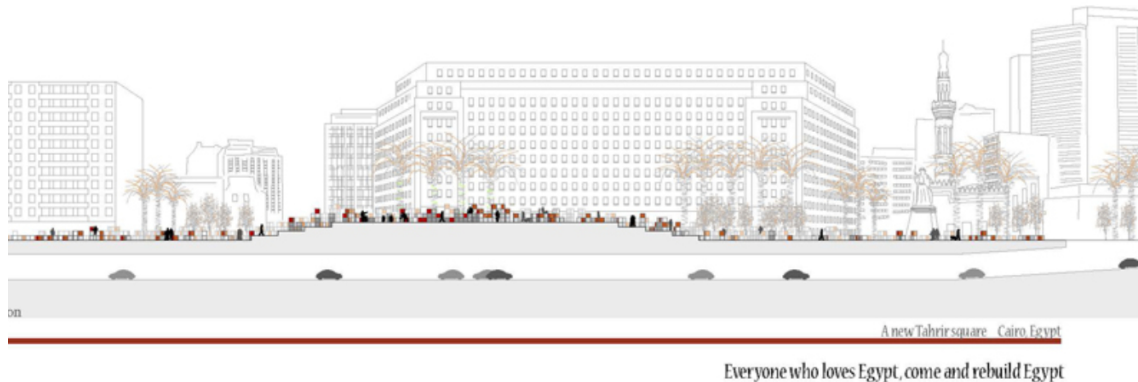

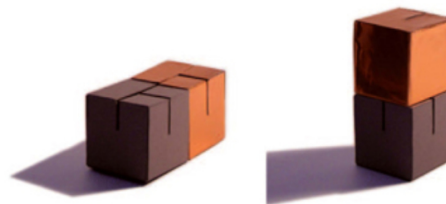
Nach der Revolution in Ägypten im Februar 2011 lobte die ICARCH Gallery in Kairo einen internationalen Ideenwettbewerb für die Neugestaltung des Tahrir Platzes aus.

In unserem Entwurf galt es, die Kraft und die Gedanken der Revolution des ägyptischen Volkes in die Neugestaltung des Platzes einzubeziehen. Das Grundprinzip besteht aus variablen Würfeln (70x70x70cm), die in ihrer Anordnung die Masse der demonstrierenden Menschen symbolisieren. Der Platz soll als ein Ort der aktiven Erinnerung fungieren. Um den Tahrir Platz als Hauptverkehrsader zu entlasten, wurde ein unterirdisches Tunnelsystem für den Entwurf entwickelt.

Modular Boxes Model

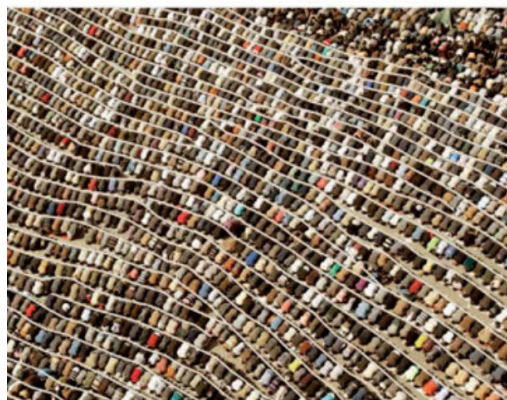
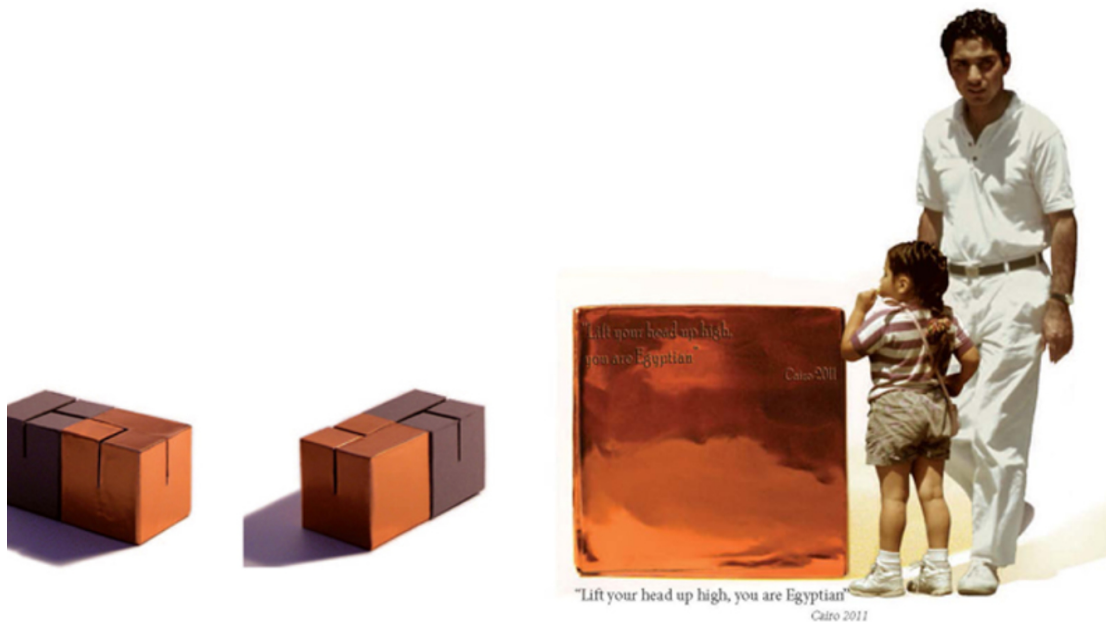
Our conception says:

The individual is not enough. Each of us is part of a whole. These simple boxes represent the individual aspect of a mass. But at the same time tell us that the optimum way to reach goals is the team work.

There are two different kinds of boxes (70x70x70cm): concrete boxes, which are fixed to the ground and metal moveable boxes. The metal boxes have a simple mechanism. So that they can be moved around the concrete boxes but they cannot be taken away from them. The team work role is in here. These metal boxes can be moved only by two or more people, because of their weight. This aspect of the project allows Egyptians to be part of the square. "Everyone who loves Egypt, come and rebuilt Egypt" and remember that they reached their dreams because they were together in all times.

In addition, in each box is written a sentence recalling the revolution sense. Such as cries of revolution or wishes for their future in a renewed democratic land.
